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However, there are also easier trails that are more accessible to NC500 road trips. One of my favorite stops along the north coast 500 was the afternoon we spent in Beinn Eighe. You imagine that, at the far north, the climate would be very hard for anything except Gorse and Heather - but the Gulf stream really has a huge impact on the local flora. After hours, you can only go to the first camera, but this is still really impressive. You can find a detailed description of the route here. Open from 10am to 17h (1 April to 31 October) Big Burn Falls Walk This hidden gem is a quick and easy walk outside the Golspie, near Dunrobin Castle. Over 1,500 Jacobites were killed in an hour and then the battle ended. Today, the battlefield is a historic site and a memorial ground for many people who have lost their lives here. I love a surprise, so when I entered the suspension bridge above the canyon, I was impressed by how narrow, deep and for a long time was. I was expecting a gorge, but this was up and beyond what other gorges look like Curti! Corrieshalloch Gorge has up to 60 m deep and 1.5 km (1 mile) long. One of my personal favorites was the beach of Achmelvich. Achmelvich Beach is a bit off the NC500 main route and requires you to drive by a small track road for a few kilometres.
